

NED Dress Code

Approved 9/1/2011

- I. Footwear:
 - a. Footwear that damages the playing surface of a green is not acceptable (e.g. cleats, spikes, nubs, heels, etc.). Shoes with flat soles are highly recommended.
 - b. The local club's custom for footwear will be respected (e.g., requiring closed toe shoes). If a local custom does not exist, no restrictions on footwear beyond I.a. will be applied.

- II. Attire:
 - a. All attire should be modest in nature and not offensive to others.
 - b. Players entering tournaments as a team must wear a uniform that identifies their team (i.e. uniforms must be closely matching in color and design). If a team elects not to wear a specific uniform, Whites will apply as the standard dress for Tournament Events.
 - c. Some variation in team uniform is allowed (e.g., shorts vs. capris vs. trousers, skirts vs. slacks, short sleeves vs. long sleeves).
 - d. Questions or clarifications on attire should be addressed to the Tournament Director, ideally in advance of the tournament start day. The Tournament Director may declare a player/team in violation of the dress code and present them with a warning. Players will be given an opportunity to remedy the infraction by changing their attire during a break in play.
 - e. If a player/team is unwilling to respond to a dress code warning from the Tournament Director, they may be disqualified (at the Director's discretion).
